<p><i>University GPA vs. Program GPA</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All grad level courses are put together in the University GPA whether they are taken as an undergraduate or graduate student. • Discussion on whether or not there is any advantage to having a University GPA? • Decision: Use program GPA for certifying students for graduation and conferring degrees. • This addition will need to be added to the Graduate School Handbook. • The Council voted unanimously that program GPA, and not university GPA should be the metric for conferring a degree.
