<i>PhD in Engineering Education and Master of Science in Engineering Education</i>	<p>Presenters: PK Imbrie and Teri Murphy The presenters gave a history of both proposals. The committee then made the following comments/recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Speak with CECH to discuss students taking courses from that college. - Did they consider other courses from CECH about human learning? - Include oral communication skills. - Recommendation to be more deliberate about the 18 hours of advance study. Add cohesive focus area for student to choose. - Will the job these individuals get allow them to pay off their education? What will the MS offer job-wise? - The MS is needed as an exit/bridge to the PhD program 	<p>PhD vote: approved with one abstaining. Approved for review by Academic Committee after signatures from CECH and Mary Boat's review of courses. MS vote: approved with 4 dissenting and one abstaining.</p>
<i>Statistical Analytics Certificate</i>	<p>Presenter: Michael Goldberg The presenter gave an overview of the certificate, with feedback from the committee as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Are there any jobs on the market that would require this degree? - It doesn't seem to include courses in data management. - What about including an ethics thought process, perhaps as a learning outcome incorporated into coursework? If not already included in degree program, incorporate into certificate. 	<p>The committee voted to put the proposal on hold until the presenter had a chance to respond to the feedback. They suggested a conversation with some of the other colleges and offered to suggest names at their colleges for the presenter to contact.</p>
<i>Discussion Topics</i>	<p>Graduate School Handbook</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CCM recommended several changes to the handbook. 	<p>Chip Montrose will make the revisions and send out to the committee for an e-vote.</p>
