## Discussion (Challenges/Ideas): Accessibility

#### Tools

Navigating assumptions concerning learning management systems (preparedness of students/faculty) - **Utilizing instructional designers** (resources exist within UC... how much with graduate student instructors), course orientations. Canvas can be inaccessible for visually impaired students - Accessibility vs Proactive Inclusivity. Planning is key – suggested that folks plan at least a semester in advance. Who is not here (how do we access undergrads who think they won't come)? - Potential focus group with instructional designers.

## **Qualifying Exams/Dissertation**

Examining what the learning outcomes are for these items. Culture of isolation and negative mental health expectations. Portfolio options – Flexibility for students: making options available. Support events for students at these stages. Petitions for alternative formats. Adjusting dissertation/exit projects submission based on student goals.
